Robust design

The modules of the Portagrass system are 2.4m x 2.4m galvanised metal frames supporting the proven StrathAyr rootzone stabilised with ReFlex® mesh elements.

The system has been designed for maximum grass growth, ease of use and durability. Air, heating and drainage channels are incorporated into the design. The system is proven by year of use.

Easily movable modules

The modules are easily moved with standard forklifts with long tines. They are best installed on a concrete stadium floor. The modules are moved into the stadium, the surface is checked and rolled, markings painted and then it is ready for play. The system provides complete flexibility in management of the playing surface.

Grass maintenance

The grass maintenance program is standard for a sand profile. The surface is normally stored and maintained at a nursery site in full sunlight, resolving problems from lack of sunlight and airflow inside the stadium.

In cold climates, Portagrass modules can be maintained in a greenhouse during winter to enable use of the surface year round. Any grass type can be used, the system is proven with Bluegrass and Couch/ Bermuda grass with the option to blend or over-sow Ryegrass.

Consistent quality playing surface

The playing surface is smooth and consistent. Joins between the Portagrass modules are barely visible, level and tight, with no effect on play. Stadia maintain spare modules to fix damaged areas and high use stadia can maintain two surfaces.

Australian tennis body

A Portagrass portable tennis court is maintained by Australian tennis' governing body to enable ties to be held on grass at various venues around Australia.

The court has been transported up to 1,800 km/1,100 miles for a tie. It is installed three weeks before use to provide the exacting surface required for tennis, on a heavy clay profile and grass cut to 4-5 mm.

A previous design of the portable court was used for three seasons of Davis Cup finals between 2001 and 2005 in Melbourne and Sydney, also yielding a first class playing surface.

NRG Stadium, Houston, Texas

NRG Stadium is a retractable roof, multi-use venue. It hosts NFL, international and major league soccer, college football, rodeos, concerts, monster trucks, Disney on Ice, circus, basketball and numerous other events. The Portagrass system was installed in 2002 to enable rapid change between grass and non-grass surfaces. The surface consisting of 1,250 modules was removed more than 20 times per year and could be installed in 10 hours and removed in eight hours. NRG stadium used the system from 2002 until 2015.

"The flexibility of having a removable turf system with a concrete floor underneath has proven essential to maximizing event activity at the Stadium. The venue is used over 100 days a year. The field is removed from the stadium around 20 times per year and is relocated within one day."

Sam Houston Race Park, Texas

The system combines a natural turf racetrack with a roadway crossing for heavy vehicles. On race days Portagrass provides a perfect racing surface. On non race days the modules are removed to create a durable roadway. The StrathAyr system has been in use since 2008.
